

**Minutes of the
San Gorgonio Pass Subbasin Stakeholder Advisory Committee Meeting
June 12, 2019**

The first meeting of the San Gorgonio Pass Stakeholder Advisory Committee Meeting was called to order by Jeff Davis, General Manager of the San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency, at 3:30 pm on June 12, 2019, in the San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency Boardroom.

Members of the Stakeholder Advisory Committee present included John Covington, Morongo Band of Mission Indians, and Larry Ellis, Banning Bench Community of Interest.

There were no members of the public present who wished to provide public comment to the Advisory Committee.

Jeff Davis presented a Power Point summarizing the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act and its impact on groundwater basins in California, and then answered questions from the Committee.

Mr. Davis then presented a Power Point providing an overview of the San Gorgonio Pass Subbasin, including potential management strategies for the subbasin.

Mr. Davis then presented a Power Point reviewing the governance structure of the subbasin and the process that the three GSA's underwent in order to select a consultant to develop the Groundwater Sustainability Plan. He noted that the selected consultant, Provost & Pritchard, has worked on a number of GSP's in High Priority basins in the San Joaquin Valley.

The Committee discussed the consultant and asked questions about its knowledge of the subbasin. Mr. Davis noted that the GSP Working Group is insisting that Provost & Pritchard meet with key stakeholders and individual members of the three GSA's early in the process, and indicated that he would take the consultants on a tour of the subbasin. He estimated that the kickoff meeting would be held in July or August.

After further discussion, the meeting adjourned at 4:40 pm.
